| 22 nd February 2018 | 'Unifrog' (Future Choices tool) launched to all Y12 during DV session and logins created http://www.unifrog.org/ |
| 2 nd March 2018 | All of Year 12 to attend University and Apprenticeship Fair at the Emirates Stadium |
| Ongoing: March-October 2018 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students to continue Future Choices research via Unifrog and other recommended sources - Students to book and attend University Open and Taster Days - 1:1 guidance sessions offered with Sixth Form Manager |
| 23rd March | Students to have completed "Post 18 Intentions" on Unifrog and ensure that "Activities" and "Competencies" on Unifrog are up to date. |
| 16th April | Uni shortlist complete on Unifrog |
| 2nd July | First draft of personal statement complete on Unifrog, and "Activities" and "Competencies" updated |
| 2 nd July 2018 | Future Choices Day |
| 3 rd July 2018 | Personal Statement Workshop. Buzzword released and UCAS online logins started www.ucas.com |
| Throughout July | As part of their Year 13 Registration, all students to show evidence of a Personal Statement or CV draft to form tutor |
| Throughout July | Students should politely ask their subject teachers (usually via e-mail) to complete a subject reference via UniFrog |
| 25 th July-4 th Sept 2018 | Summer Holidays- students should spend time updating their Personal Statements and utilising the UniFrog tools |
| 4th September | Students to have a final personal statement draft, that only needs minor amendments |

| 14 th September 2018 | Students to have completed a second draft of their Personal statement or CV via Unifrog and begin/review University/Apprenticeship shortlists |
| 21 st September 2018 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Early Entry (EE) references completed on UniFrog by subject staff · Form Tutors begin writing the references for EE students · Form Tutors begin drafting all other UCAS references where the UniFrog references have been completed by subject staff |
| 5 th October 2018 | WEALD DEADLINE: EE applications completed by students and Form Tutors. Online Payment made by student direct to UCAS |
| 8 th October 2018 | All EE applications checked by Mr Backshall |
| 10 th October 2018 | EE applications sent by Mrs Tucker (UCAS deadline = 15 th October 2015) |
| 15 th October 2018 | UCAS DEADLINE: Deadline for Early Entry applications, including the reference, to Oxford, Cambridge and most courses in medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine and veterinary science. Check deadline details in the UCAS search tool |
| 19 th October 2018 | Subject Teachers to have completed all references via UniFrog |
| 2 nd November 2018 | Form Tutor references completed in Unifrog and uploaded to UCAS |
| 23 rd November 2018 | WEALD DEADLINE: All UCAS applications to be fully completed by students (excluding EE/Oxbridge). Online payment made by student direct to UCAS |
| 15 th January 2019 | UCAS DEADLINE: Deadline for the majority of undergraduate courses Exception: some Art and Design courses with a 24 March deadline. Check the UCAS 'Course information' screens on Course Search for the Art and Design courses you are interested in, to find out if they have a 15 th January or 24 th March deadline |
| 24 th March 2019 | UCAS DEADLINE: Application deadline for all applications for Art and Design courses except those listed with a 15 January deadline. |

Applications received by the above deadlines are guaranteed to be considered by the universities and colleges. Applications received at UCAS after the deadlines, up until **30 June 2019**, will only be considered by the universities and colleges if they still have vacancies in the course(s) you have selected.
