Opal Coast 2019 Permission Letter and Info

Final details are now being put together prior to the residential visit to The Opal Coast from 2nd-5th July 2019. Once again we would like to thank you for all your support.

We have been informed by Aqualaud that boys must conform to French Water Park Regulations. They will therefore be required to wear speedo type swimming trunks. Whilst we realise this may not be popular, it is purely on safety grounds. We have included a photo of what is acceptable; it doesn't seem to matter if they are slightly longer, however they do need to be fitted. Although this is a private booking, the same rules apply. We would also strongly suggest girls wear swimming costumes rather than bikinis, once again for safety. T-shirts or other tops are not permitted.

There will be a meeting on Tuesday June 11th at 6.00pm in The School Hall to go over any final points of the trip. Prior to this, your child will be given a booklet, covering all details of the residential trip.

I need to inform you that the booklet will include your child's name, room number and group leader. The aim of this is to ensure that your child knows in advance who their group leader will be and who they will be sharing a room with, so they are confident in advance about arrangements. Prior to publishing this, the school requires permission from all the Opal Coast student's parents/carers. Please could you complete the google form to give your permission by **Monday 25th February 2019**, in order for printing to go ahead.
