 <u>DO:</u> <u>RED Revision Strategies</u> Parents / friends testing you Write, cover, learn, write Revision cards and test yourself Quizlets/Seneca Learning Mind maps Keyword tests Reviewing topics you are NOT confident with Practice questions 	 AVOID: Writing notes out for a long time Reading over the textbook / notes for a long time Using untrusted websites Revising with your phone on/music Revising with a laptop or computer where you are tempted to go on Youtube, etc. Reviewing topics you already know really well first
