Dear Year 10 Students & Parents/Carers,

Save the Date - Sixth Form Open Event, Wednesday 17 June 2026

I hope that the recent RS GCSE exams have gone well and students are looking forward to commencing their half term break. As Year 10 enters its final stages and Year 11 will commence soon, it is time for Year 10 to give some thought to what they may wish to do beyond their GCSEs. I will be speaking to them in assembly about this shortly and we will be holding various events throughout the next few terms to help them with this decision and transition.
