Y10 Performance of 'An Inspector Calls'

We are delighted to inform you that Globe Players Theatre Company will be visiting us on Friday 1 May 2026 to perform 'An Inspector Calls' for all Year Y10 students. As you are aware, this is one of the set texts for GCSE English Literature, and responses on 'An Inspector Calls' make up 25% of the final GCSE grade.

To support student comprehension, The Globe Players intersperse their presentation of key scenes with explanation. Being able to see it performed will hugely benefit students in their understanding and allow them to respond with greater depth. They will have a better appreciation of Priestley's intentions and how the audience might respond.

As I am sure you can understand, there is a cost implication, however by inviting them into school we have been able to provide this at a far more affordable cost than a theatre trip. You are invited to contribute £5.50 by Friday 1 May 2026. This is available to pay on ParentPay. You are not obliged to make this contribution, but if insufficient funds are received, it is possible that the performance will be cancelled.
