

Important information: Outstanding HPV vaccination

The Immunisation Service are coming into school for a **HPV** (Human Papillomavirus) vaccination catch up session on **Monday 6 July 2026** to offer this vaccine to students in years **9, 10** and **11** who have not yet received the HPV vaccination, which is routinely offered in year 8.

If this applies to your child and:

- You have already completed and returned a consent form; the Immunisation Service will offer this vaccination at the upcoming catch-up session in school. Where a consent form was submitted in a previous school year, your local Immunisation Team will contact you prior to offering this vaccination.

OR

- You consented for your child to receive this vaccination at a different school, and it is still outstanding, please contact your local Immunisation team on **01273 696011 ext. 8100** so that they can update your child's consent form.

OR

- You have not yet consented and would like to do so please request the consent information from your child's school.

Students now only require one dose of the HPV vaccination in total.
