**Y11 GCSE Mathematics - Additional exam revision session & breakfast warm-up sessions**

To support students in achieving their full potential in the upcoming Maths GCSE exams, the department is running a double lesson revision session the week before the final Maths paper. All students are invited to attend this revision session as it is during students' study leave. This session will be on Tuesday 4 June periods 1 & 2 for Q half students and Wednesday 5 June periods 1 & 2 for P half students.

In addition, we will be running our popular breakfast warm-up sessions on the morning of each Maths paper. This is designed to support students with Maths questions just prior to their exam to help build confidence before entering the exam hall. There will be breakfast snacks available for all students who attend.

Details of the revision sessions are as follows:

**GCSE Maths Paper 1 (Exam date: Thursday 16 May 9.00am)**

- Thursday 16 May (Breakfast warm-up - 7:30am - 8:30am) - Dance studio

**GCSE Maths Paper 2 (Exam date: Monday 3 June 9.00am)**

- Monday 3 June (Breakfast warm-up - 7:30am - 8:30am) - Dance studio

**GCSE Maths Paper 3 (Exam date: Monday 10 June 9.00am)**

- Q half students - Tuesday 4 June (periods 1&2 - 9.10am - 10.50am) - Normal Maths rooms
- P half students - Wednesday 5 June (periods 1&2 - 9.10am - 10.50am) - Normal Maths rooms
- Monday 10 June (Breakfast warm-up - 7.30am - 8.30am) - Dance studio

Students do not need to wear school uniform once they are on study leave, but they will need to bring their own equipment, including a scientific calculator, plus their exam ID card.

Your child will also be given past papers, online access to past papers and additional revision resources throughout the exam period via their Maths google classroom. Please contact me or your child's teacher if you require any further information or additional resources.

Having run these sessions in previous years it was apparent from the results that those who do attend enhance their final grade. Thank you in advance for your support and we look forward to continuing to support the students in these additional sessions.
