- Compulsory tasks. These are not due until the end of the second full week of term in September. Some students will complete this in their study periods after term has begun but if you'd like to get a head start, the information is there. In the first few weeks, you'll have some sort of small assessment in each subject to ensure that you are coping with the demands of the course. It will be based, to some extent, on this content.
