### **Year 11 'Results.Reflect.Revise.' Evening Wednesday 18 March**

Year 11 students have concluded their second, and final, set of mock exams on Friday 27 February. They have conducted themselves in an exemplary fashion and we are really proud of all of the hard work and commitment which they have put into their mock preparation.

Parents and carers will receive the results of these mock exams, as usual, in the tracking report in late March. However, we would also like to invite you and your Year 11 student(s) to a **'Results.Reflect.Revise.'** evening. At this event, Year 11 mock 2 results will be available in 'summer exam style' (i.e. in envelopes collected at the event). Students who do not attend, will be able to access their mock results via their Bromcom student portal the following day. Students are not obliged to open their envelopes there and then and we provide some quiet spaces, should they be required.

This evening will take place on **Wednesday 18 March** in the School Hall from **6.00pm - 7.30pm**. There will be an introduction from Miss Cortizo, Deputy Headteacher, a presentation from the Head of Year 11, Mr Brixey, which will include presentations from the English, Maths, and Science teams, who will discuss and demonstrate the most effective ways to revise in each subject. We will cover how [RED Review](#) (revision strategies which really work) can be applied across all subjects. We strongly encourage you to sit with your child as the presentation includes pause points to reflect through discussion with your child.

At the end of this event, students in attendance (who have ordered one) can sign for and receive their graduation hoodie and may wear it in place of their blazer from Friday 20 March (Thursday 19 March is Enrichment Day 2). Students who do not attend this event will receive their hoodies the following Monday (23 March). It will not be logistically possible to distribute hoodies one by one before then.

We hope that this event will offer practical strategies and guidance to help you support your child as they move closer towards their final exams. The form allows you to indicate if you would like an additional chair, should one become available. We will confirm availability on Monday 16 March and will allocate additional chairs on a first come, first served basis.

There may be some limited parking on site (via Staines Street), however this is largely weather dependent, so we advise that you park in the car park at the leisure centre side of the school, our additional car park in Luxford Way or in the surrounding side streets.
