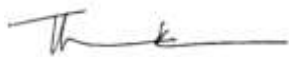
GCSE results day August 2026

I am writing to confirm arrangements for GCSE results days this year.

- GCSE results will be available for Year 11s from **8.00am** on **Thursday 20 August**.
- The results can be collected in person from the Sixth Form Centre using the Stane Street entrance (please note that the front entrance will be closed).
- Staff will be available to provide advice and guidance if you have questions once results are released.
- This will include The Weald Sixth Form team, who will be able to support you with any queries regarding entrance offers and course requirements at The Weald.
- There will be a form to sign if you would like to give us permission to use your anonymised exam papers/scripts for data analysis and teaching purposes.
- The school will be open until 11.00am for results to be collected. Thereafter, we will upload results to the Student Portal of Bromcom and, additionally, post hard copy results home.
- Students will have the opportunity to register for the new Government DfE Education Records app. This is a free app (downloadable from your app store - search "Education Record England" [Apple](#) or [Google](#)) and once registered it will hold all your exam information to share digitally with future colleges / universities / employers.
 - Students will have needed to have downloaded the app prior to arriving to collect results. The app requires iOS version 15.0 or newer and the Android version requires 8.1 or newer.
 - To activate the app each student requires a unique QR code. This will be created for students to scan in the Sixth Form Centre and this will then activate the account.
 - Results would be automatically published to the app after 11.00am on Thursday 20 August. *This does not replace collecting results in person.*
- If you are unable to collect your results in person and do not want to wait until 11am for them to be published on Bromcom, you are able to nominate someone to do this on your behalf. You can do this by sending an email to exams@theweald.org.uk confirming who the person is. That person will then need to bring some form of identification with them when they arrive at school to collect your results.
