**Year 11 'Results.Reflect.Revise.' Evening**

As you will be aware, Year 11 students are about to sit their second, and final, set of mock exams in the week beginning 10 February. These exams will conclude on Friday 28 February. The details of when these mock exams are and how to prepare for them can be found in our [Year 11 Information Booklet here](#).

Parents and carers will receive the results of these mock exams, as usual, in the tracking report in late March, however we would also like to invite you and your Year 11 student(s) to a 'Results.Reflect.Revise.' evening. At this event, Year 11 mock 2 results will be available for the first time in 'summer exam style' (i.e. in envelopes which can be collected and opened, should students wish to, at the event). Students who do not attend, will be able to access their mock exams via their Bromcom student portal the following day.

This evening will take place on Thursday 20 March in the School Hall from 5.30pm - 7.00pm. There will be a brief introduction from the Head of Year 11, Mrs Gardner, and this will be followed by presentations from the directors of English, Maths, and Science, who will discuss and demonstrate the most effective ways of revising each of these subjects. We will also cover how [RED Review](#) (a set of revision strategies which really work) can be applied in options subjects as well.

Students will not only be able to receive their mock 2 results for the first time, but also their Year 11 hoodies will be available for those students who attend to collect. Students who do not attend, will be able to collect their hoodie on Friday 28 March, in the Year 11 assembly.

We hope that this will offer practical strategies and guidance to help you support your children as they move closer towards their final exams and look forward to seeing you at this event.


