Enrichment Day - Thursday 19 March 2026

Our second enrichment day of the academic year is **Thursday 19 March**, and we are delighted to be able to offer a day packed full of opportunities for all our year 7 students.

We have a number of in school activities and day trips on offer. For those activities that take place within the normal school day parents are not obliged to make a contribution, however, the cost of travel, activities and meals fall outside of the normal day for trips. It is probable that if insufficient monies are received, the trip will have to be cancelled.

If a situation occurs where a trip becomes oversubscribed, a lottery system will be used to select students fairly.

Off site trips:

• The Observatory Science Centre, Herstmonceux - £25.00pp

Students will visit the discovery centre where everyone can experience Spectacular Science through the medium of interactive activities- every exhibit is designed to be played with to see what happens; investigate, learn and have fun!

• Hercules The Musical, Theatre Royal Drury Lane London - £42.50pp

Get ready for an afternoon of fantastic musical theatre. The musical, inspired by the animated film, **based on the ancient myth. It's what classical civilisation would have wanted.** Ancient Greece. A time of gods, mortals... and Hercules, who isn't quite either. But if he's not a god, how can he possibly save the world from Hades?
