
I am writing ahead of the Year 7 assessments, which will take place in the fortnight beginning 12 January 2026. These assessments will take place in class and your child will be informed by their teachers when this assessment will take place.

These assessments will check learning from across Key Stage 3 so far and will allow your child to demonstrate the progress they are making in the curriculum. We will share the results of these assessments (in the form of a percentage) in their next tracking report. You will have the opportunity to discuss these assessments, alongside how to prepare for the next set of assessments (which take place in May), with your child's teachers at Parents' and Carers' Evening on Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 April 2026.

Below is a summary of the topic/s your child will be assessed on for each subject. Your child's teachers will be setting them revision (**RED Review**) as their ONLY homework in the 4 weeks leading up to the assessment to support their preparation.
