## Key Stage 3 Homework Club

Year 7 have had a brilliant start to their life as part of the Weald community and I have been incredibly proud to see enthusiasm in lessons, kindness in corridors and friendships blossoming in social time. I hope that your child has had a positive experience in their first two weeks with us and encourage you to contact their form tutor if you (or they) have any concerns.
