Key Points to Remember:

- Uniform Checks: Uniforms will be checked at the school gate each morning to ensure compliance and by tutors and staff throughout the day.
- **Replacements:** If your child requires replacement uniform items, please make arrangements to purchase these at your earliest convenience. Second hand uniforms are available from the following parent-led <u>facebook page</u>. For children in receipt of free school meals, we will always support with purchasing items if needed.
- Weather Consideration: With the winter months, we encourage students to bring a coat to be worn over their blazers for added warmth.

Consequences for Non-Compliance:

- Students not in the correct uniform will be placed in detention. This is at break and lunchtime with a 10 minute break allowance for food and the toilet.
- Persistent uniform infringements recorded on the students' Weald Card will result in further action, including an after school detention, as per our school policy.
