ACE stands for Alternative Curriculum Experience and ACE Week is your chance to get involved in a range of activities that you wouldn't normally be able to do. You've been sent this booklet because you're either in Year 8 or in Year 7 or 9 and not going on a residential trip and this booklet is a guide to the activities that are available to you to choose during ACE Week.

All of the activities within this booklet offer you an exciting and alternative experience in addition to your studies. Some of the activities have a cost attached to them, but many of them are **free**. Your activity on Monday will be with your year group so you need to choose what you would like to do on Tuesday-Friday.

NEW for 2024 - there are a selection of day trips on Wednesday 3 July in yellow - If you choose this as an option, you will need to choose at least one activity shown in green as your Tuesday option. One day activities are also available on site for Thursday-Friday stated in green.

There is also an overnight residential option for both year groups displayed in blue. If you would like to choose this, this is an option IN ADDITION to the day activities, so please choose a day activity for Tuesday/Wednesday as well as a blue option.

Please read through the option details in this booklet and then choose a 1st / 2nd / 3rd / 4th choice and complete this Google form.

What you need to do:

- 1) Choose **EITHER** one activity from Tuesday to Wednesday (2 days white or green) **OR** one yellow day trip **AND** one green activity
- 2) Choose one two-day activity (white or green) or at least two one day activities green options from Thursday to Friday

When the activity allocations have been confirmed, you will receive a personalised letter confirming which ones you are on and, in the case of an activity that carries a charge, how you can pay for that on ParentPay.
