### **Enrichment Day - Thursday 19 March 2026**

Our second enrichment day of the academic year is **Thursday 19 March**, and we are delighted to be able to offer a day packed full of opportunities for all our year 11 students.

We have a number of in school activities and day trips on offer. For those activities that take place within the normal school day parents are not obliged to make a contribution, however, the cost of travel, activities and meals fall outside of the normal day for trips. It is probable that if insufficient monies are received, the trip will have to be cancelled.

If a situation occurs where a trip becomes oversubscribed, a lottery system will be used to select students fairly.

#### **Off site trips:**

- **Out of Bounds trip - Brain Rest Day - £40.50pp**

This exciting day will consist of an array of in and outdoor activities to suit everyone, and great for supporting physical and mental health, building confidence and team-building.

Coach travel and a minimum of 3 activities from:

- **Adventure Nets** (high ropes, bouncy nets, and exhilarating slides)
- **Bowling 1 Game** (a state-of-the-art facility and equipment included, shoes and bowling balls of various sizes and weights.)
- **18 Holes of Adventure Golf** (a 18-hole Safari Themed Adventure Golf course offers exciting challenges and laughs for everyone.)
- **High Ropes/Zip Lines** (designed for thrill-seekers, this activity tests both physical and mental strength.)

**In school activity** - if your child is not on a trip they will attend school as normal.

- **Study skills & mental health day - Free of charge**

Students will take part in various onsite activities including study skills sessions to help with their upcoming exams.

Once your child has been allocated a trip, the voluntary contribution is payable via ParentPay by Monday 2 February.
