Year 8, 9 and 10

Welcome Evening - Thursday 25 September 5.30pm - 7.00pm

Firstly, we would like to take this opportunity to say what an excellent start students have made this week. Students have settled in well: arriving at school punctually and in excellent uniform, well prepared for lessons and ready to learn. This is an excellent foundation on which to build and we thank you for your continued support in their positive, focused approach to school and sixth form college.

To build on this positive start we would like to extend a warm invitation to our Welcome Evening on Thursday 25 September. The focus of this event is to start the year by equipping you with the information, resources and channels of communication you need to work with us in supporting your child to achieve their best this year. **We will seek to outline what ‘working well’ at The Weald looks like and how we can work together to ensure your child achieves this.** There will be a particular focus on the cycles of revision and review, assessment and reporting, alongside other aspects of the curriculum (including enrichment) and student wellbeing.

As year 9 have just started their GCSE courses the presentation will also feature some key information on how GCSEs work in 2025, GCSE grading and how to support your child through a three year GCSE course.

We are aware that some families may have students in multiple year groups on the same evening. If you are not able to attend more than one talk, please be reassured that much of the content is similar and we will share all resources on the website afterwards, so dates and details specific to a year group can be found there.

Information Stands

Throughout the afternoon there will be information stands available in the E block canteen. Please drop in and take a look whenever it suits you. These stands will cover a wide range of aspects of school life, including IT systems, homework, extra curricular clubs, Inclusion, assessment and tracking. Key staff, including senior teachers will be available to answer questions and offer information. It is not possible to meet your child's teachers individually, but you will be able to do this later in the year at your child's parents and carers evening.

Parking

Please be aware that parking on the school site is limited, so if you are local and it is possible to walk, both the front and Sixth Form entrances will be open. There will also be extended parking on the school fields (weather permitting) with the entrance via the bus lanes. **Please note this will only be available from 3:30pm to allow the buses to leave.** A number of disabled parking spaces are available at the front of the school. If you have any special access requirements, please advise your child's form tutor. There are a very limited number of spaces available in the main car park. Please ensure you only park in the white parking bays (which are the school bays). The blue ones are for use by the Leisure Centre only. There will be 6th form students who will direct you to the field parking entrance. The "What3Words" reference is: arise.meanings.encroach.

Safeguarding

We have a Pastoral Team who will always put the voice of the child first and this includes their Form Tutor and Head of House/Sixth Form team. 
