RSHE Policy Consultation Evening - 01 May 2024

As part of our wider school policy, we are reviewing and updating our Relationships, Sex and Health Education policy. I would like to invite you to a consultation on the new draft policy here in our school hall on Wednesday 1 May at 5.00pm. It is our aim that the policy reflects the attitudes of our parents and carers as much as possible, and of course meets our legal duty.

Our aim of the Relationship, Sex and Health Education curriculum at The Weald remains to provide knowledge and understanding of relationships based on love and respect, and to develop an understanding of attitudes and choices surrounding all relationships. The purpose of the policy is to have this stated in an easy to understand way, which will be used to shape the nature and content of lessons.

Within the meeting, I will outline what our legal obligations are regarding the teaching of relationships, sex and health and how our lessons meet them. I will show you some extracts of our current lessons so you can gain a deeper understanding of what our RSHE lessons are actually like and I will also inform you of how you are able to find out more about this area of our curriculum should you wish to. Finally, I will be happy to answer any questions you might have about the policy, or the RSHE curriculum itself.
