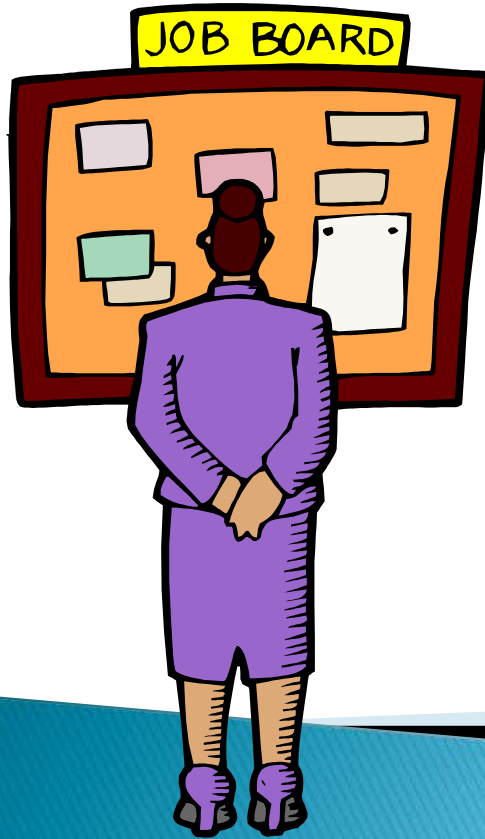

Apprenticeships



A job:

- At least 30 hours a week
- Paid at least £3.50 / hr (from 1st April '17)
- 20 days holidays a year + bank holidays
- Levels 1 – 7
- 12 – 18 months to complete Levels 1-2
- 18 – 24 months to complete Level 3
- 3-5 years to complete Levels 4-6.

Training:

Recognised industry based training provided by an accredited training provider either at college, university, training centre or all on the job site.

Apprenticeships



Functional Skills (level 2):

- English
- Maths
- ICT

Even though an apprenticeship may include English and maths an employer may not recruit you if you do not have them at 4 grade of above

STUDENTS NEED TO HAVE FOUND AN EMPLOYER BEFORE THEY ARE ABLE TO START AN APPRENTICESHIP

Apprenticeships



Ways to find an apprenticeship:

Use your contacts, family & friends and ask for work.

Contact local employers directly, ask for work experience/weekend work now with the chance for an apprenticeship after year 11



Apprenticeships

Go directly to the larger companies you want to work and apply via their websites
(for example JCB apprenticeship applications start October 2017)

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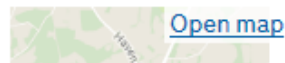

Higher/ Degree Apprenticeships

Higher/Degree apprenticeships are offered at levels 4-7 (HND – Masters)

There is a steady increase (4% more) people starting Degree apprenticeships from 2014/15 and 2015/16

Remember:



- It is a job – research the company, be presentable, know why you want to work there, what you can offer them.
- It is not the easy option – you have to find the job, be interviewed against other candidates and start life in the world of work
- You may still need your GCSEs at grade 4 in English and maths as a minimum requirement

Remember:



- It is very rewarding to earn your own salary and be more independent
- It is excellent for your career progression to get a qualification at the same time as real time / real life work experience
- You can get the same level of qualification as any one else without having a student debt.
