

Join the toy library for just £2 and borrow 3 toys for up to 3 weeks for free.





Library multi-sensory story magic schedule

Join a multi-sensory story time session specially for children and young people with additional needs. Horsham, last Saturday of the month, 10.30am - 11.15am children to teens.



This is a new way of giving parents information written by local midwives and health visitors. Sent directly to your mails inbox, this information is available when it suits you, on your phone, tablet or PC.

What you will get from Family Assist:

- Important info sent to your email to guide you though pregnancy, labour and the early stages of your child's life
- Ability to include Dad's, partners and other families and friends
- "Ask a Question" facility, answered within 2 working days
- (in development) Live Chats directly with a local midwife or health visitor
- Lots of more information covering everything from your first scan and screening to registering the birth, immunisation and healthy eating for your child and much more

Baby Buddy App

This offers guidance through your pregnancy and the first six months of your baby's life. It can help with supporting you on your emotional, physical and social journey through pregnancy and becoming a new parent. Designed with both parents and professionals you will be able to access a wide range of short films, track services and groups near you, find out useful facts and information specific to your child each day, keep track of your appointments and keep photo memories of your baby growing up and more.



Free Childcare

What is Free Entitlement?

Free Entitlement (FE) is Government funding for free childcare for all eligible children regardless of their individual needs or their citizenship status. FE is up to 570 hours per year of flexible free childcare available to all 3 and 4 year olds and eligible 2 year olds. Some 3 and 4 year olds are eligible for an additional 570 (up to 1,140) hours per year, which we call Extended FE, if they meet the eligibility criteria.

There are three types of FE funding:

Free places are available at eligible childminders, pre-schools and day nurseries (along with some out of school clubs and holiday play schemes meeting extra criteria). These childcare providers are known as 'settings'.

The Freedom Programme

Do you feel afraid of your partner a lot of the time? Is your partner excessively jealous and possessive?



Do you feel you are walking on eggshells to avoid making your partner aggressive or angry?

Is your partner constantly criticising you and putting you down? Does you partner tell you what to wear, who to see and where you can or cannot go?

The Freedom Programme is a FREE, twelve week rolling programme open to any woman who wants to learn more about the reality of domestic abuse. Each session is an hour and a half.

The course will enable women to:

Recognise the signs and tactics used by an abuser

Realise the effects this behaviour can have on a woman & her children Avoid further abusive relationships in the future

Gain self-esteem and confidence to enable independence and a better quality of life

Meet others who have had and moved on from similar experiences

What type of issues do we work with? Young people are faced with many issues relating to the challenges of adolescence which may include school, family & relationship problems that come with this difficult time. When young people find the pressure too much to manage this can present in behaviours such as:

- Self-harming
- Anxiety
- Sleeplessness
- Low self-esteem & confidence
- Difficulty with eating & weight
- Low mood and mild depression
- Difficult relationships at home & with friends
- Disengagement from participation & education
- Anger issues
