Dear Student, Parent/Carer,

A-Level/BTEC results days August 2024

I am writing to confirm arrangements for KS5 results days this year ([\(please click here to view a letter to students from Ofqual and UCAS\)](#)).

- Results will be available for Year 13 from 8.30am on Thursday 15 August.
- Results can be collected in person from the Sixth Form Centre using the Stane Street entrance (please note that the front entrance will be closed).
- As a school, we will have knowledge of your results from Wednesday 14 August and can call you on that day (if [you have indicated](#) that you want to be told) if the results mean that you have not met the terms of your UCAS offer (but will not be able to share your actual results). Although there is never a guarantee, from previous experience we have seen that some universities will accept students who haven't quite met their offer, but some will not. Should you be in this situation, the Sixth Form team will be on hand on Thursday morning to support you through the next steps of the Clearing Process and provide guidance.
- There will be a form to sign if you would like to give us permission to use your anonymised scripts for data analysis and teaching purposes.
- The school will be open until 11am for results to be collected. Thereafter we will upload results to the Student Portal of Bromcom and, additionally, post hard copy results home.
- If you are unable to collect your results in person and do not want to wait until 11 am for them to be published on Bromcom, you are able to nominate someone to do this on your behalf. You can do this by sending an email to exams@theweald.org.uk confirming who the person is. That person will then need to bring some form of identification with them when they arrive at school to collect your results.
