(Level 3 only) Present overview of project and evaluation to an audience of peers.

Ensure project meets stated project conventions and submit for final grading.

Submit work for formal feedback against AO1, AO2, AO3 (Develop and Realise) and AO4 (Review).

Evaluate progress against stated objectives, and evaluate value of process for current studies and future goals.

Create main part of project: dissertation; investigation; performance; or artefact.

Submit work for formal feedback against AO1 (Manage) and AO2 (Use Resources)

Use research to formulate a plan for main project.

Conduct academic research on chosen topic, recording findings in an appropriate way and creating a bibliography.



Explore big questions to develop deeper thinking about ethical issues.

Identify a topic for exploration and formulate a question or client brief, breaking this down into clear objectives.

All Levels (1, 2, and 3) follow the same process but to differing degrees.
