Offers

In addition to your applications, we are delighted to have received 90 applications from students at schools other than The Weald, and we are in the process of meeting with all of them individually. These meetings are taking place throughout February, and once they are complete, we will be able to send out offers to all applicants.

Replying to offers

You will need to respond to your offer via Admissions Plus to confirm that you would like to join us in 6th Form, and we will let you know the timescale for doing this within the offer details.

Changing subjects

It is common for students to change their subject choices after they have applied and we are very happy to accommodate this where we can (subject to timetabling). You are able to make any changes within your application right now, and once you have confirmed your offer, the subject choices will be locked until enrolment day, where you will have the opportunity to discuss and amend your subject choices.
