Dear Parent/Carer,

Surrey Storm Netball vs Celtic Dragons

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to watch the Surrey Storm Netball team play Celtic Dragons at Surrey Sports Park on Monday 20 March 2023. The match begins at 7.30pm, but we will be leaving school at 6.15pm. So please arrive by the Leisure Centre entrance at 6.00pm latest. We hope to arrive back between 9.30pm and 10.00pm. Updates on estimated time of arrival will go on social media as and when possible. It is encouraged that students eat before attending but can bring snacks (inoffensive food and drink) with them in a small backpack to consume during the game if they wish. Food and drink at Surrey Sports Park is extremely limited.

The cost of the ticket is **£22.00** which covers the cost of the ticket itself and travel to and from Surrey Sports Park via Minibus. **If your child is successful in obtaining a place on the trip then it will appear on the ParentPay system on Tuesday 7 February with a payment deadline of 9am Monday 27 February.**

Parents/carers should pay for the trip using ParentPay, at www.parentpay.com using their unique login and password. Please note that payment for the trip through ParentPay acts as parental permission and therefore no reply slip is necessary. If you would prefer to pay by cash, you may do so at your local Paypoint retailer using a barcoded letter. Please note that payments are non-refundable as the school makes a financial commitment to the tour operators and other companies based on the number of places we book. Should you secure a place for your child and subsequently decide to cancel, you may be liable to pay any outstanding balance in full, which we have already committed to the operators or venues. However, if your child is unable to travel due to ill health, a medical certificate to cover the date/dates involved from GP/hospital will be required in order that a claim can be made through the school insurance. Without this evidence we will be unable to make any refund.

Terms and Conditions


