Subject	Year 10
Art/Ceramics	Up to 1 to 2 hours per week which will mostly be research tasks.
Business Studies	Business Studies and Business Communication Systems students - 1 hour per week
Drama	Written exam practice - at least once per week, Rehearsals for performance work, especially in Spring/Summer terms - twice per week
English	One main homework set per week. Average length 1 hour, but may be longer when preparing for controlled assessment.
Food Technology	Set as appropriate. Normally one per week of up to 1 hour.
Geography GCSE	Total homework 1 hour per week. Either one extended piece of work or two shorter pieces.
Health & Social Care	Once per week, up to 1 1/2 hours.
History	1 per week of 45 minutes to an hour.
ICT	Typically 30-60 minutes per fortnight
Languages	Once a week, up to 1-1.5 hours.
Travel & Tourism	Homework set once per week - 1 hour per week. In addition students will need to keep an up-to-date travel & tourism news review folder.
Maths	Set once per week as appropriate depending on timetable. Duration expected to be up to 1 1/2 hours.

Music	Once per week plus ongoing coursework. One to one and a half hours.
Music Technology (BTEC level 2 Award)	Once per week to include ongoing practical assignment work in M3. One to one and a half hours.
Design and Technology (Product Design, Systems and Control, Textiles)	Normally once per week where appropriate, up to 60-90 minutes.
IBEC	One per fortnight, lasting up to an hour
Science	Typically one homework for each teacher per fortnight. One to one and a half hours each
