Subject	Year 11
Art/Ceramics	Up to 1 to 2 hours per week which will mostly be research tasks.
Business Studies	Business Studies and Business Communication Systems students - 1 hour per week
Drama	Twice per week - ongoing rehearsals and practical work. In addition, notes for written controlled coursework to be prepared for homework.
English	One main homework set per week. Average length 1 hour, but may be longer when preparing for controlled assessment and examination tasks.
Food Technology	Set as appropriate. Normally practice exam questions and research tasks. One per week of up to 1 hour. Additional time may be required during revision periods.
Geography GCSE	Total homework 1 hour per week. Either one extended piece of work or two shorter pieces.
Health & Social Care	Once per week, up to 1 1/2 hours. Usually from the pre-prepared revision booklet.
History	1 per week of 45 minutes to an hour.
ICT	Typically 30-60 minutes per fortnight
Languages	Once a week, up to 1-1.5 hours.
Travel & Tourism	No Year 11 group.
Maths	Set once per week as appropriate depending on timetable. Duration expected to be up to 1 1/2 hours.
Music	Once per week plus ongoing coursework. Length as appropriate
Psychology Short Course	One or two homeworks per week, each of 45 minutes
Design and Technology (Product Design, Systems and Control, Textiles)	Once per week where appropriate plus ongoing coursework typically up to 60-90 minutes
IBEC	Two per fortnight, lasting up to an hour
