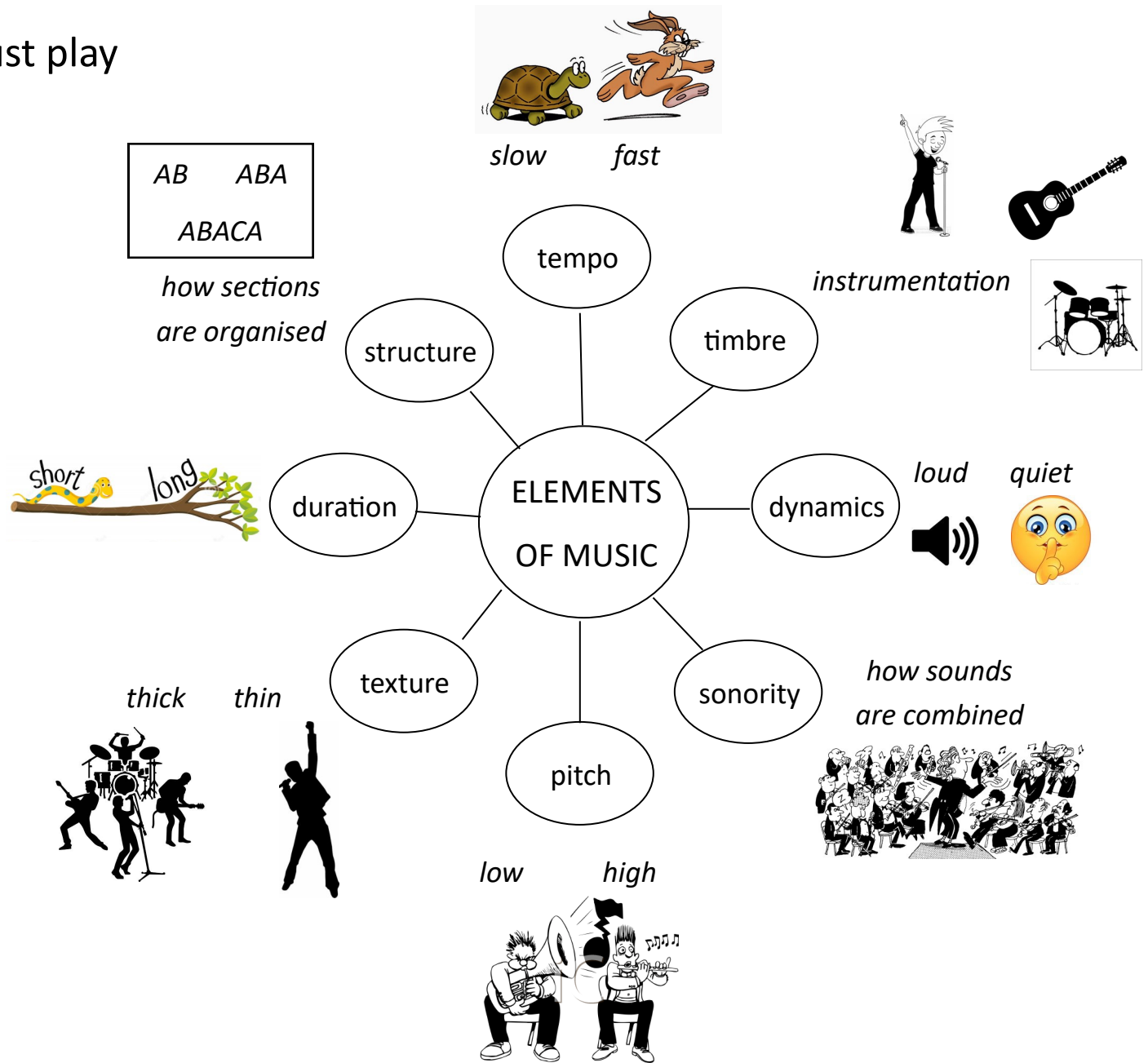


YEAR 7 KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER

Project 1: Find your voice & just play

KEYWORDS	
Melody	A line of single notes often the main focus of a piece
Harmony	Notes played or sung at the same time to make chords
Chord	Two or more notes played or sung at the same time
Strumming Pattern	A rhythmic pattern strummed on the strings of a guitar or ukulele
Bass Line	Low pitched single notes which fit with the rhythm and chords
Rhythm	A pattern of different length notes
Ensemble	A group of musicians playing music together
Major Chord	A bright happy sounding chord
Minor Chord	A sad or serious sounding chord



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Project 2: The Classical Approach

KEYWORDS

Treble Clef	A symbol that represents notes played at a medium to high pitch.
Bass Clef	A symbol that represents notes played at a lower pitch.
Staff Notation	A way of recording music on paper using dots and lines.
Stave	The 5 lines on which notation is written.
Rhythm	A pattern of different length notes.
Balanced Melody	A melody which divides into two similar halves.
Ternary Form	A musical structure that has 3 sections—ABA
Drone	A sustained or repeated note.
