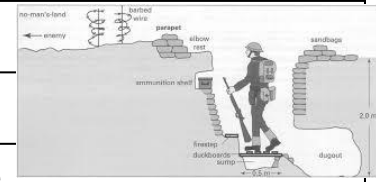

<b>Imperialism</b>	A desire to build a big empire, or bigger than your rivals
	A belief in your country over others
<b>Assassination</b>	
<b>Militarism</b>	A belief in having a strong military and a desire to use it

	Forcing civilians to join the armed forces
<b>Memorial</b>	A act or structure dedicated to remembrance
<b>Remembrance</b>	The act of remembering a significant event
