

Welcome to Sixth Form 2020 - A-level preparation for Year 11 - June 2020

I'm excited to be sending you details of preparatory activities that our Sixth Form teachers have been getting ready for you. Our amazing teachers have prepared a range of introductory activities to help students who will join our Sixth Form in September feel prepared for and engaged in the courses that they will be taking.

We always set a range of activities to prepare students for entry into the Sixth Form but, this year we really feel it is crucial that we go beyond what we have previously offered because of the situation Year 11 students find themselves in. Students in Year 11 have now not been in taught lessons since 20th March and have not sat the exams that they were working so hard for. Many students I have spoken to have expressed a wish to maintain a routine of academic work so that they can feel as prepared as possible for A-level study in September. I have been hugely impressed by the ways in which many Year 11 students have chosen to keep themselves occupied and academically challenged. Lots of students have signed up for online courses, often run by universities or worked on developing new skills ranging from learning British Sign Language to taking up yoga.

Below you will find codes that will allow you to access the Google Classrooms for the subjects you wish to take in the Sixth Form. You will need to access these using your Weald school email or a Gmail account. When you go into Google Classroom there is a + sign in the top right hand corner. Click on this and then select 'Join class'. Type in the relevant class code and click join. Then you will be able to see the activities and guidance that teachers have provided. If you have any difficulty with this Mr Cooper has kindly produced a short clip explaining how to access Google Classroom.
