Dear Parent/Carer,

**Re: Receiving exam results for GCSEs, A-Levels & EPQ, Summer 2020**

I hope that this letter finds you and your families well.

We have been discussing how best to inform students of their exam results this year which, given the circumstances, will be different to previous years. Although we are keen to provide students the opportunity to celebrate together, it is also necessary to consider the current social distancing guidance and the constraints that apply. As a result, as much as we would like to be able to invite students in to school to receive their exam results and to celebrate with us, this year we feel that it would be prudent to ask that students do not congregate on the school premises and, instead, celebrate with their friends and peers in a safer way. Therefore, we will be releasing the results through the Insight parent portal at 8am on Thursday 13th August. We will also be releasing appointment sheets at the same time on Insight should your son or daughter wish to discuss their results in person or on the phone with a member of staff on Thursday morning. These appointments will be for students whose results mean they have not met the requirements for their courses and who may need assistance with the Clearing process. Students and parents should not come to the school unless an appointment has been confirmed with a member of staff. The exams manager, Mrs Gould, will also be available via email on Thursday and Friday morning should you have any questions regarding the appeals process or other related, more generic exam issues. The Appeals process will be very different this year, as a result of the fact that students will not have sat examinations, and a further letter explaining this will follow shortly.

In addition, we will be sending out all examination results by first class post to your home address.
